# Experience of Japanese Culture in Yokohama! 「日本文化をヨコハマで体験する!」

Greetings from Yokohama City University (YCU).

We are pleased to announce that, <u>from March 4 to March 8, 2019</u>, YCU will offer a 5-day program focusing on experiencing Japanese culture in Yokohama. We are looking forward to receiving applications from the students worldwide. The Program will be conducted in Japanese language (JLPT Level N3 or above is necessary to understand the lectures).

#### **Program Summary**

YCU will provide this 5-day course on the Japanese Culture conducted in Japanese. In this course, you can experience the Japanese traditional performance "Gidayu-bushi" (義太夫節), one form of Japan's traditional arts of story-telling together with traditional musical performance of "Shami-sen" (三味線). The participants will learn Japanese traditional culture, stories, language and visit some historic town and site in field trips. In addition, the course intends to offer the participants opportunities to develop Japanese language skills by interacting with YCU's Japanese students. Since the course will be offered in Japanese, the participants should have Intermediate-level Japanese ability. (Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N3 or above.)

## What does the program scholarship offer?

The Program scholarship offer applicants:

- The opportunity to spend a week at Yokohama City University to learn about Japanese Culture and Language.
- Hotel expenses (single room) will be covered by YCU from March 3 (check-in) to March 9 (check-out).

- The program tuition will be waived in full. (However the tuition to be waived does not include the local and field trip transportation fee.)
- An opportunity to exchange ideas with Japanese and other international students.
